K3550	TJM Badge (37 x 67)	2	
	TJM Badge Jig Drawing	1	
	(Section 5.2D)	, I	
	Cardboard	170 mm x 130 mm	

- 1 Print out the TJM Badge Jig Drawing.
- 2 Cut the TJM Badge Jig Drawing with scissors by leaving at least 10mm distance from lines. See ILL 1
- 3 Place and tape the drawing on the Cardboard (170mm X 130mm).
- 4 Cut the lines by using a knife and a ruler to make staright cut. See ILL 2
- 5 Remove the cut piece.
- Wrap the cut piece by tape to increase strength. See ILL 3



- 7 Place the jig on the canopoy. Align bottom with canopy horizontally. See ILL 4
- 8 Align and place the K3550, TJM Badge (37 X 67) between the end point of window and canopy.
